

Restore Previous Shooter's Files

Automatic Back-Up Protection: Even with all the Password Protection built into the system, it would still be possible for someone to turn on the computer and **Uninstall** the DryFire software. Thereby, destroying all the information the shooters have input into the system and all the data associated with target counting. To prevent this from being a fatal act, the Squadding software saves all of the Shooter's Information files (containing the shooters critical information) and the target count information in a special location on disk every time you exit the Squadding software. Therefore, in the event the Squadding program gets removed or destroyed, you will still be able to reload the Squadding software and then restore all the shooters files to get the system back to its original state.

Follow this Procedure

DO NOT plug the DryFire unit in now. Later in the process you will be instructed to plug the DryFire unit in.

Place the DryFire Squadding disk in your CD ROM. Your CD ROM drive should auto-start, so give your computer at least 2 minutes to wake-up and auto-start. If your drive auto-started, you will soon see the screen shown below.

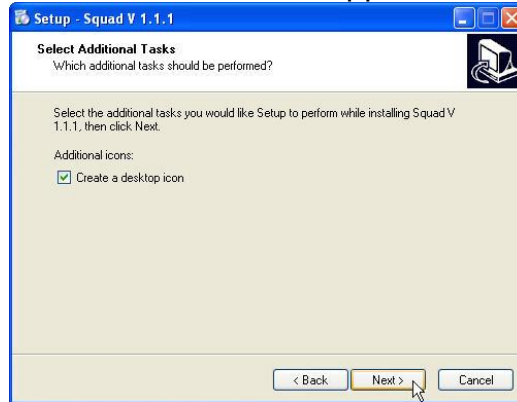
Note: If your drive doesn't auto-start, access the files on your CD-ROM drive and double click on the (setup.exe) file.

This screen will appear



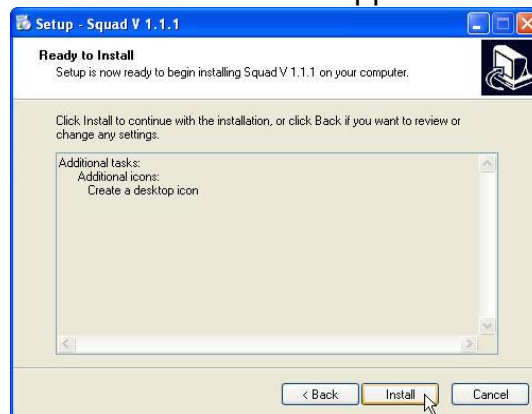
Click "Next."

This screen will appear.



Click "Next" again.

Click "Install."

The software installs, and then this screen will appear.



Click "Finish."

Now, plug the USB cable and power cable into the DryFire unit. The **USB** and **Dongle** drivers will still be loaded within the operating system, so you are ready to begin.

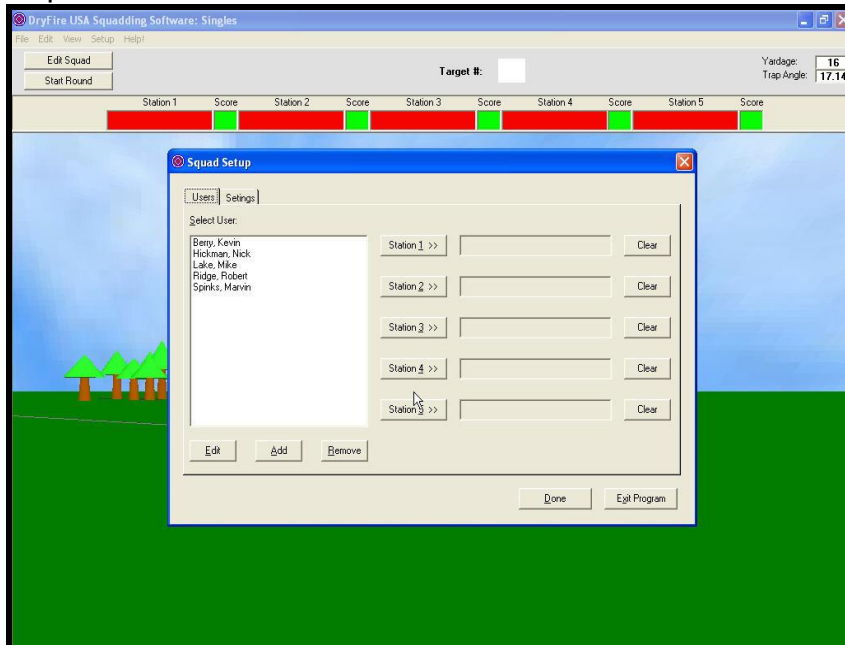


Double click on the Squadding Icon



After reading the safety message, click on "I understand"

Below, we are looking at the Squad Setup screen super-imposed on the main shooting screen. In order to be able to access the Main Menu Bar, it will be necessary to put one shooter on a Station and then click "Done."

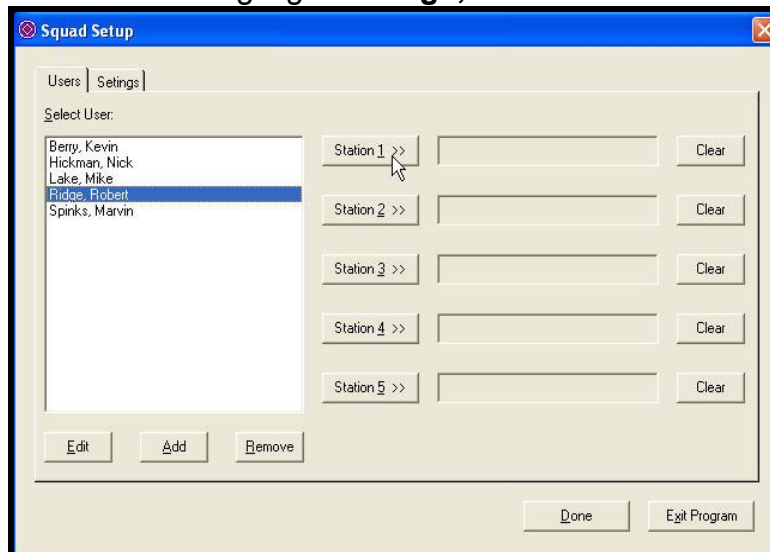


Below is the list of original passwords.

Each of the five preloaded shooters Passwords and Nick Names are listed below.

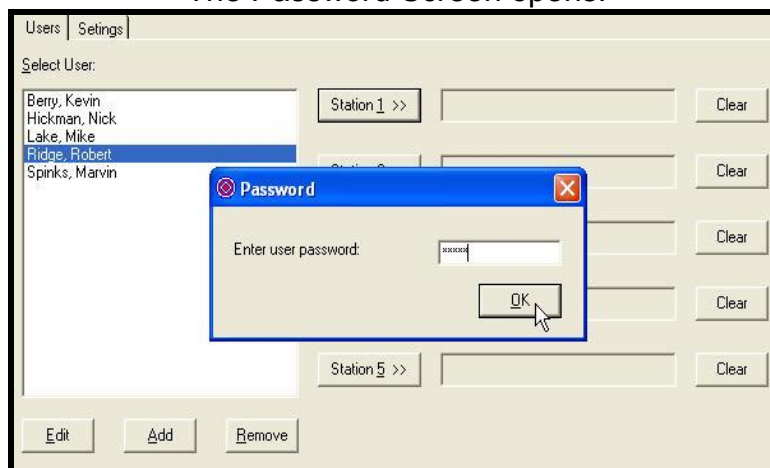

Highlight "Ridge, Robert"



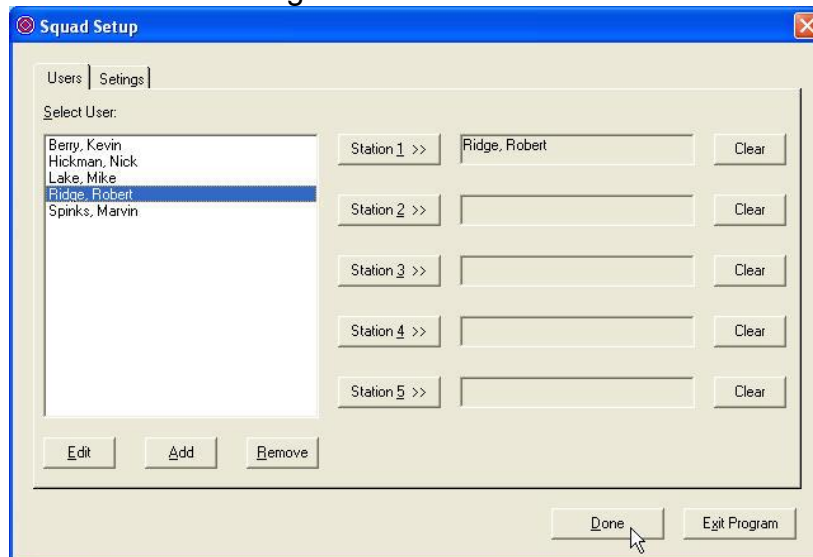
Click Station 1

The Password Screen opens.



Type in the password, in this case, **water** (all lower case) and click OK.

Robert Ridge is now shown on Station 1



Click **“Done”**

On the Main Screen, click on **“Setup”**



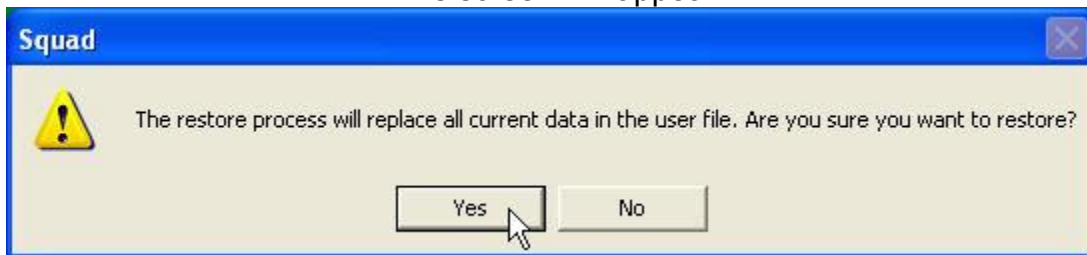
Click on **“Restore Previous Shooter Data”**

The system will respond by asking for the Administrator's Password.



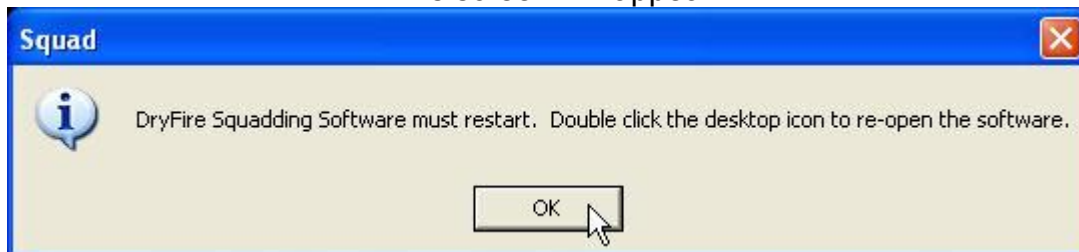
Type in the original password **dryfire** (all lower case) and click **“OK.”**

You have reloaded the Squadding Software, restored the Shooter's Information Files, and restored the Target Count Information.

Note: All the passwords being used prior to reloading the software have been restored, however, **dryfire** is the current Administrator's password. Do not leave **dryfire** as your Administrator's password.



Double click on the Squadding Icon and immediately go to the Configuration Setting Screen and change the Administrator password to something you can remember.
