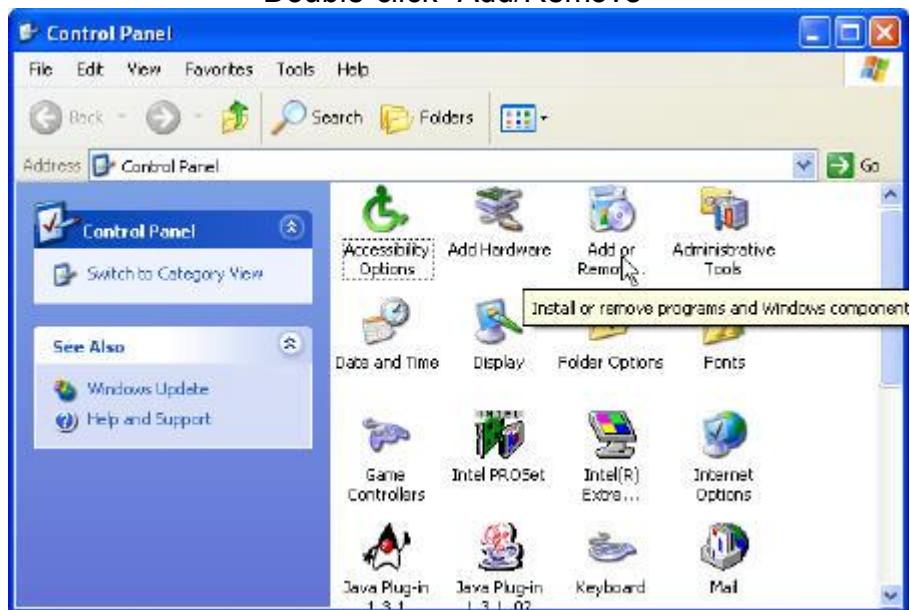
Click on the Start button.



Click on "Control Panel"

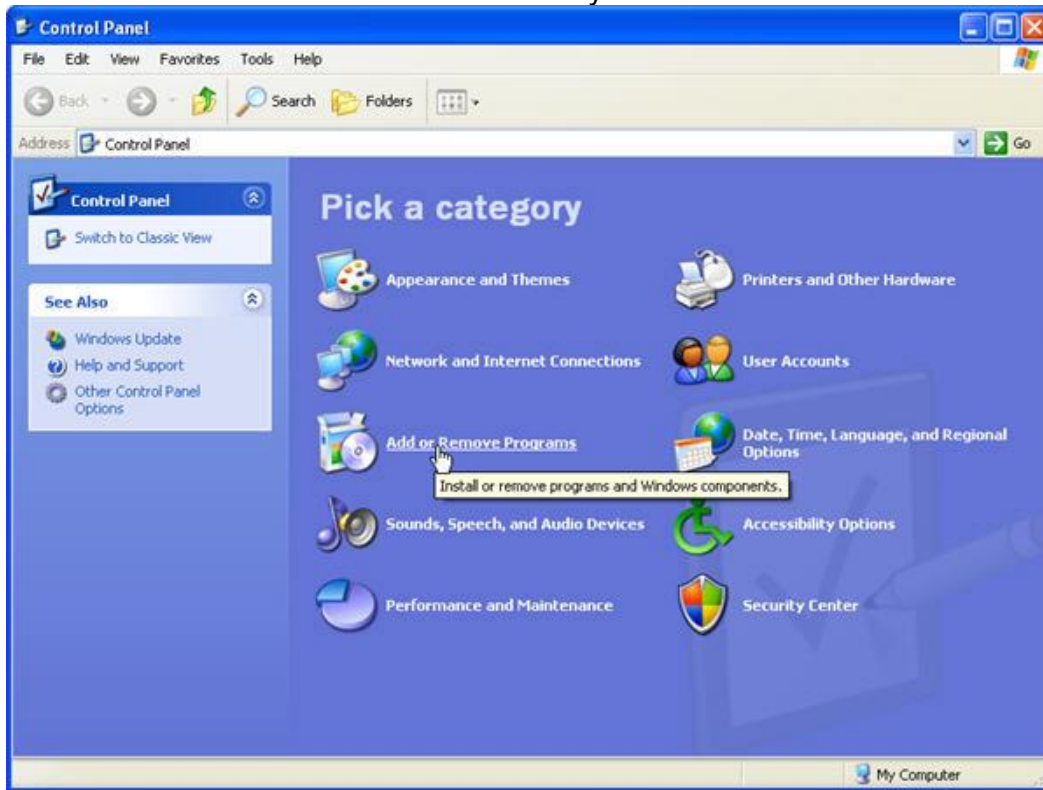


Double-click "Add/Remove"

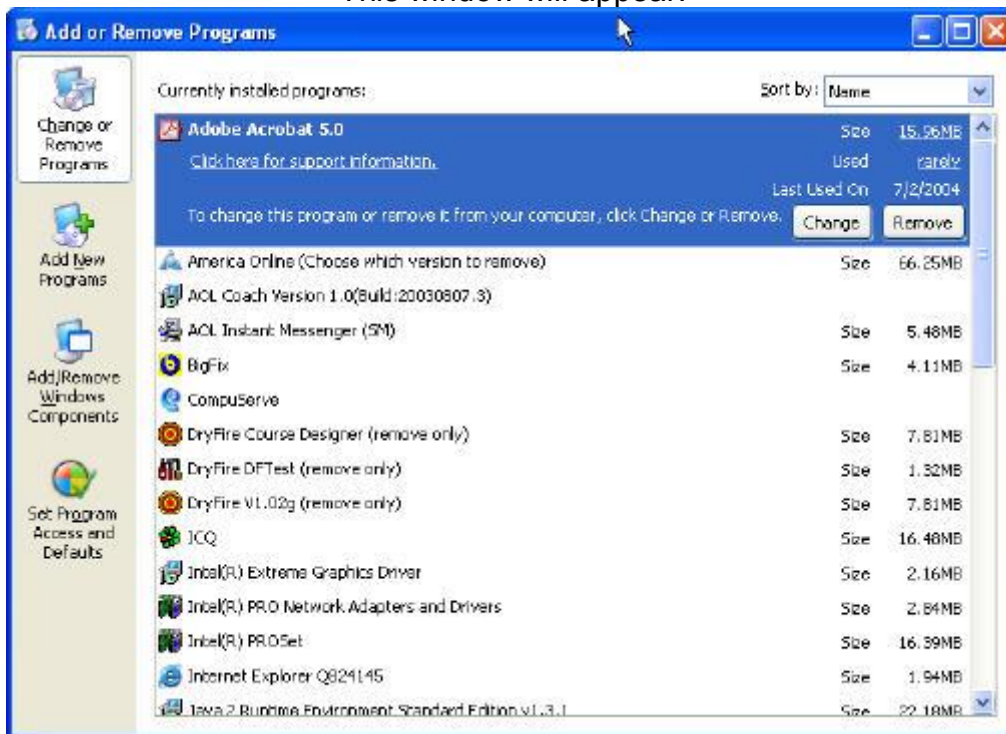


# Remove Previous Version of DryFire

Your Control Panel may look like this.



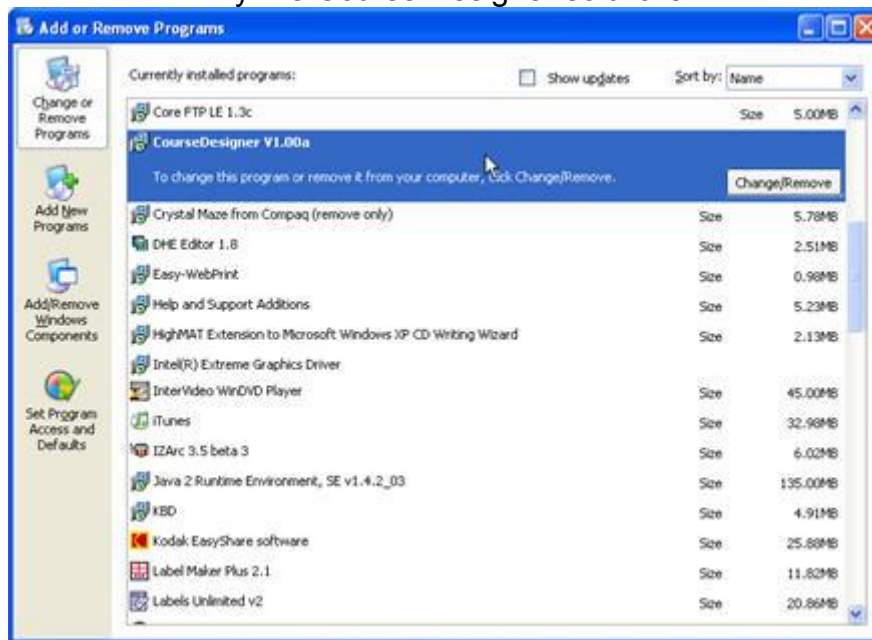

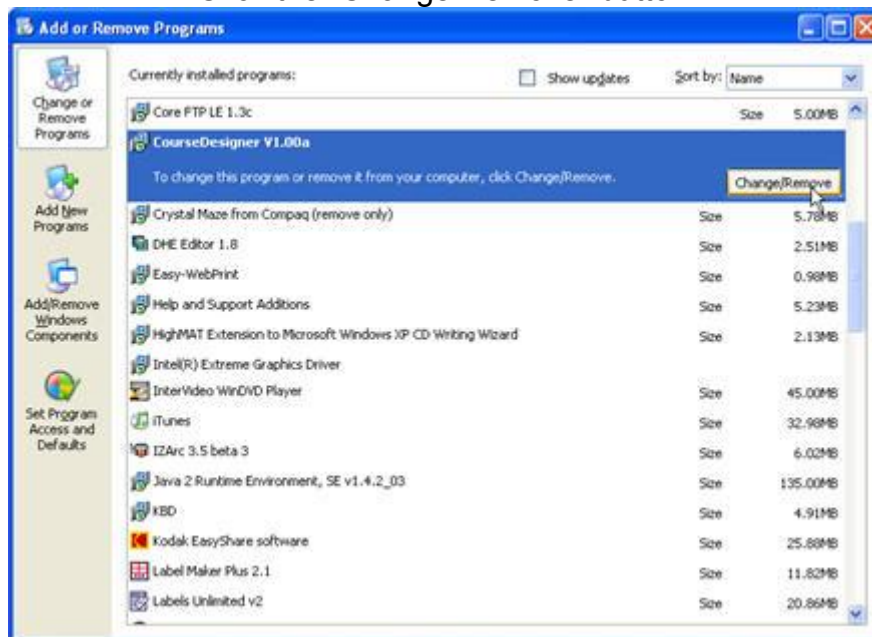
# Remove Previous Version of DryFire

If you have installed the Course Designer software, you must uninstall it first.

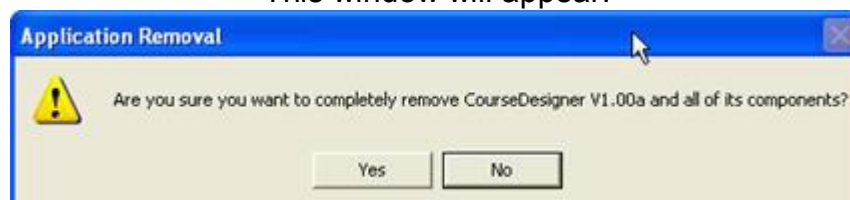
To do this, with the “Add/Remove Programs” window still up, find and click on the DryFire Course Designer software.



Click the “Change/Remove” button.

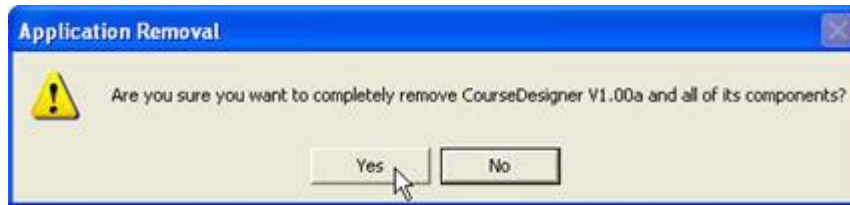

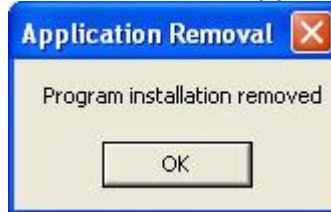

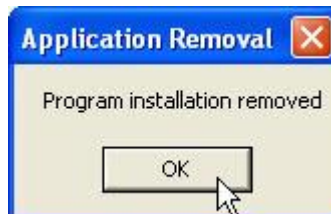
Click "Yes"



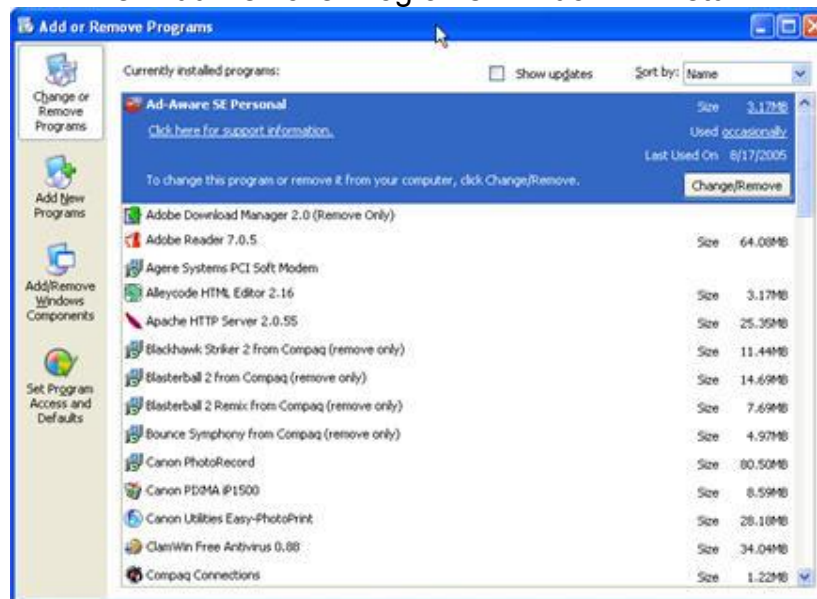

Click "Ok"

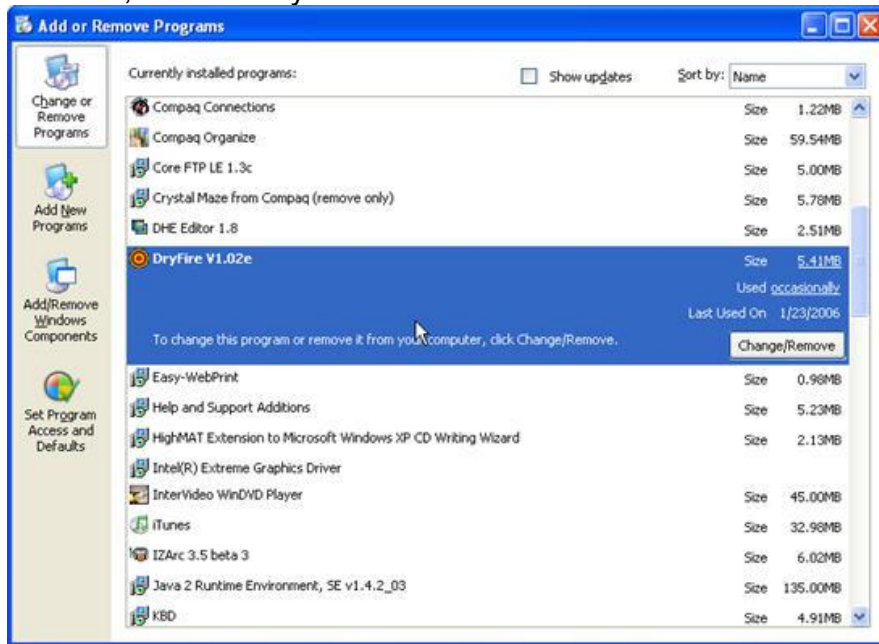


The "Add/Remove Programs" window will return.

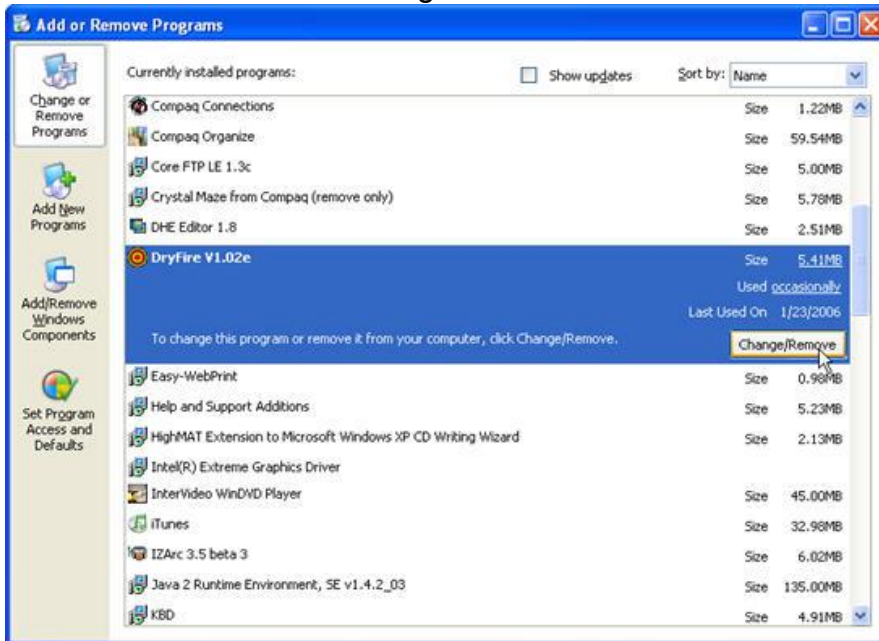

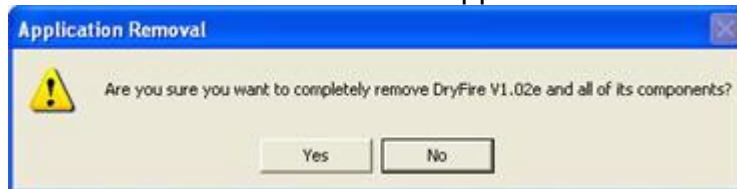
Next, find the DryFire software in the list and click on it.



Click the "Change/Remove" button.

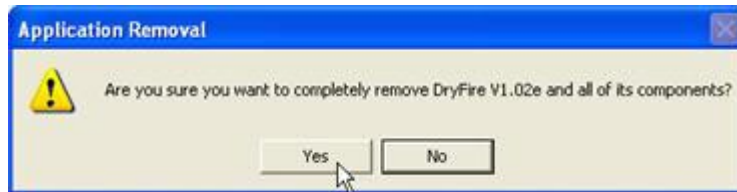

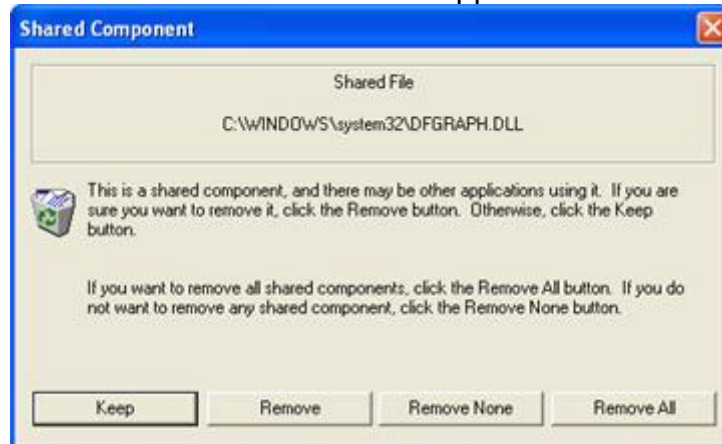

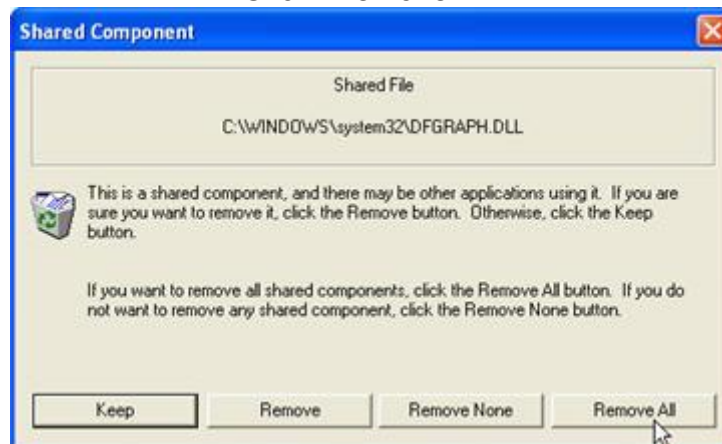
Click "Yes"



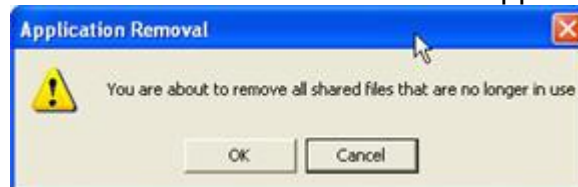
This window will appear.



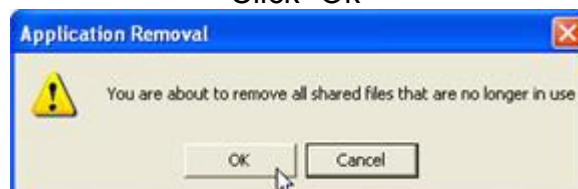
Click "Remove All"



Another confirmation window will appear.

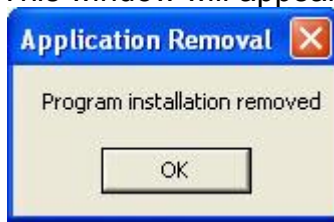


Click "Ok"



# Remove Previous Version of DryFire

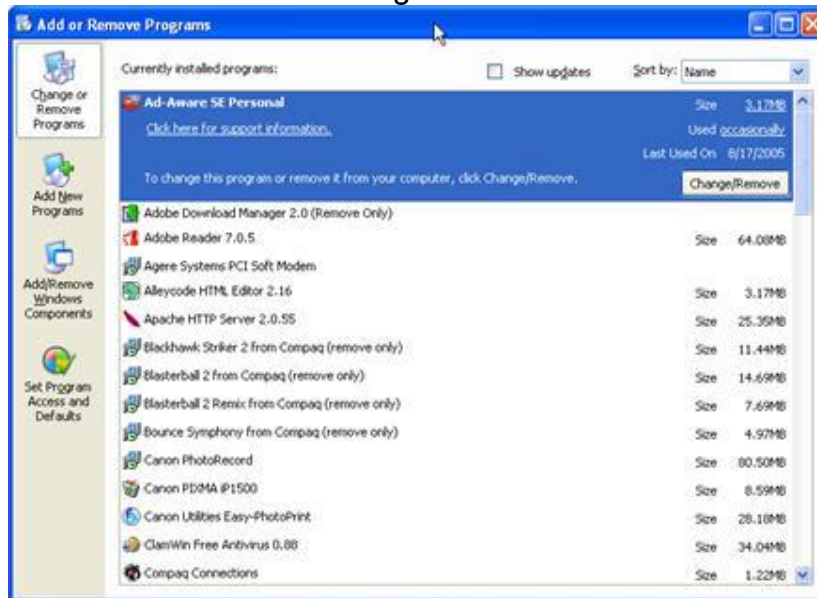
This window will appear.
