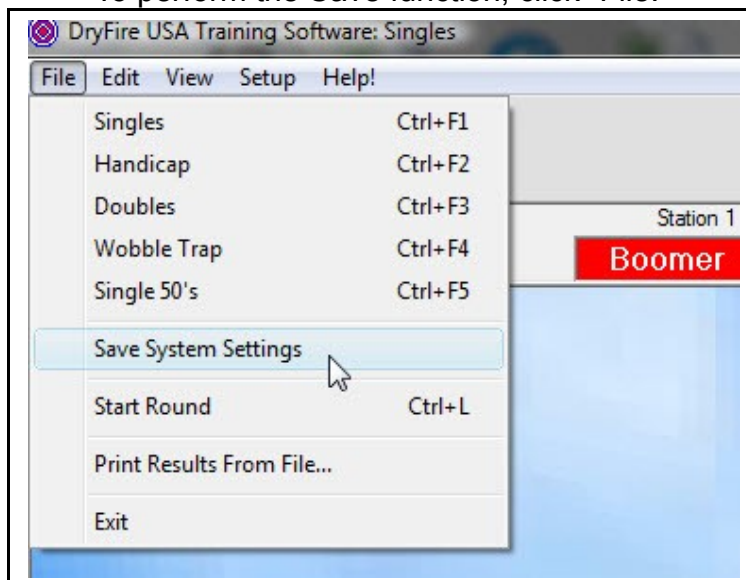


On occasion a customer will call and indicate that something has gone wrong with their computer system and they can no longer enter the DryFire software. When this happens, the only solution is to reload the DryFire software. In the reloading process, all the unique information you have entered into the software package will be lost. However, there is a way to recover all this information and return your system to normal. The restore process can and will return your system back to the state it was in before the failure occurred.

Here is how the Save and Restore Feature works. You can save a current copy of all the unique information in your system at anytime. The system maintains the last two saved copies in an encrypted format and hides them somewhere on your disk.

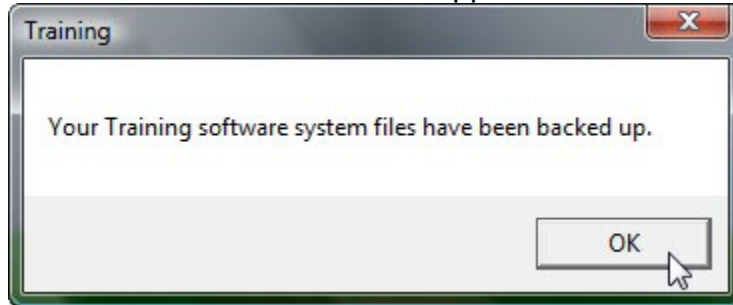
In the event you need this information, you can use the Restore process to return this unique information to the system. Therefore, even if the worst possible event happens, the DryFire software can be reinstalled and then the unique data can be restored. This means recovery is always possible, unless your computer goes bad and can't be fixed without replacing the disk drive. During the recovery process you will choose between "Restore from last backup" or "Restore from next to last backup."

To perform the Save function, click "File."



Then click "Save System Settings"

This screen will appear.



Click "OK"

Yes, it is that simple and every time you do this simple process, you save a fresh copy of your unique data and the oldest previously saved copy is thrown away.

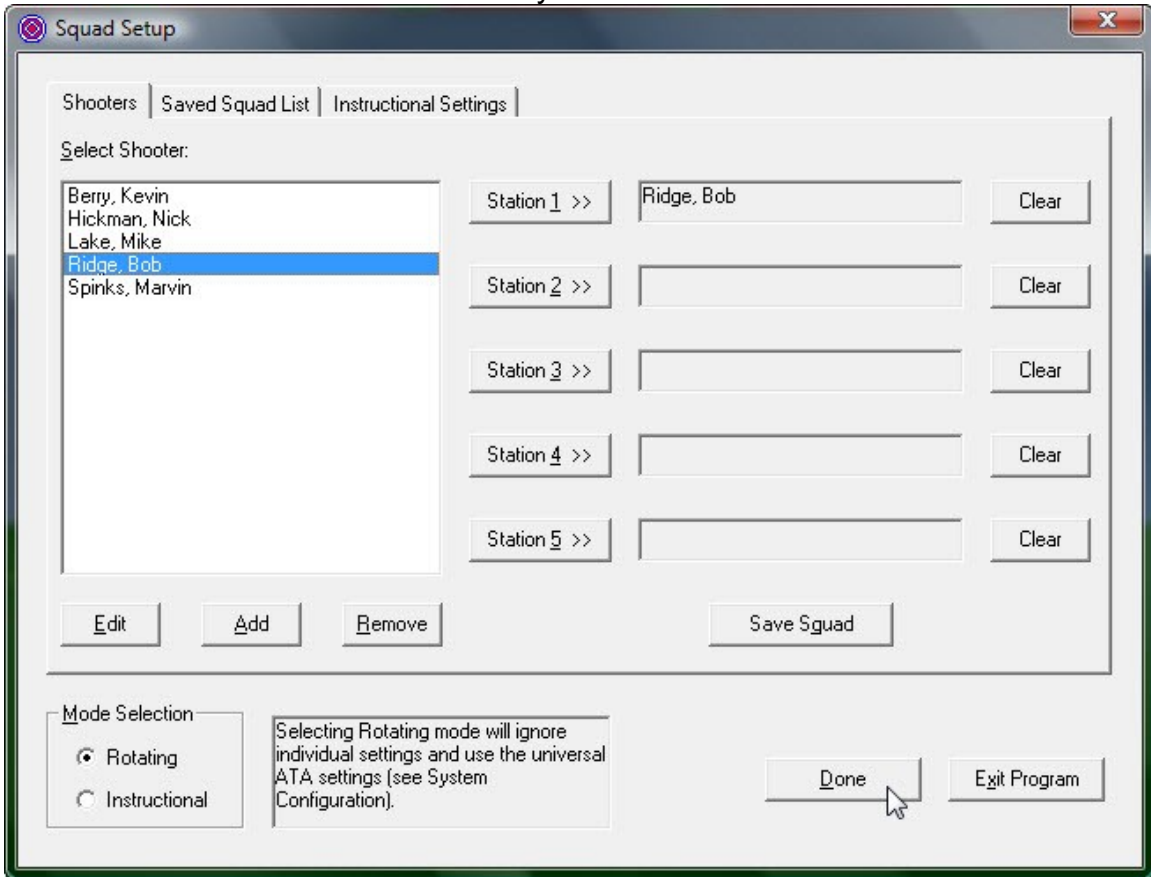
Let's assume a failure has occurred and you had to reload the software. Follow this process to "Restore" your system.

After the software is reloaded, begin by double clicking on your Training software ICON.

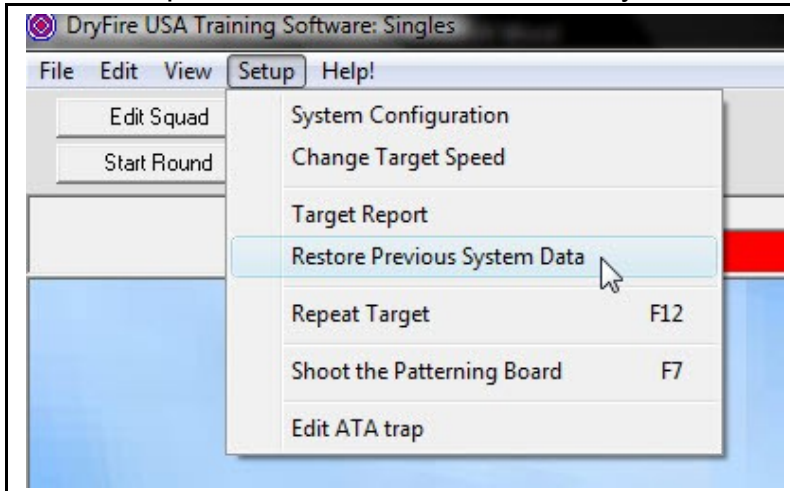


Click on "I understand"

Place one shooter on any station and then click “Done”



Click “Setup” and then “Restore Previous System Data”



This screen will appear.



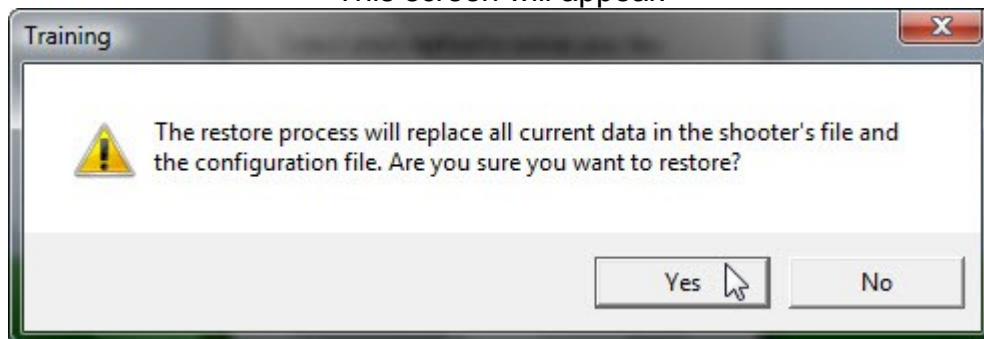
Enter the administrator password “dryfire” and click “OK”

This screen will appear.



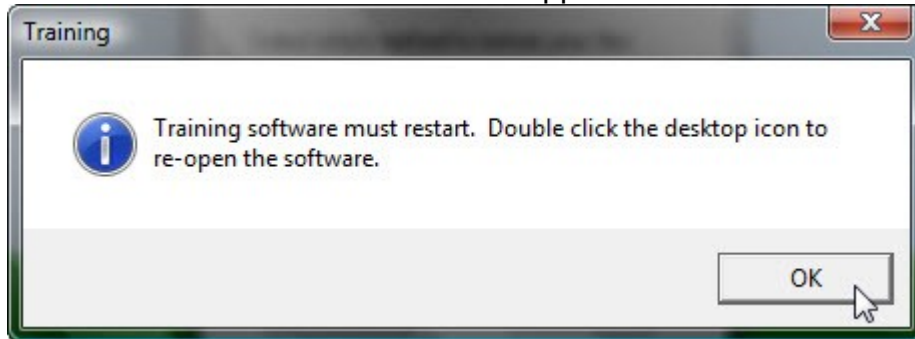
Determine which of the two available backups you want to restore and select by clicking the appropriate radial button. Then click “OK”

This screen will appear.



Click “Yes”

This screen will appear.



Click "OK" and you will be taken back to the desktop.

Your system has now been completely Restored. Now, when you double click on you Training system ICON and enter the DryFire world, everything will look normal.
